#### How do I choose a class and enrol my child?

Please take a look at our 'DANCE STAR PROGRAM' journey page, which details the clear progression through the school. To register your interest in a class as a new customer, you will need to complete an online registration form via our website and from there our friendly office team will be in touch to discuss the most suitable class for your child and answer any queries you may have.

#### Am I able to trial a class before I join?

We offer a fabulous three-week enrolment process for new students - your child will receive a three-week trial in their appropriate class at the price of just two weeks - so the third class is our gift to you! You pay upfront for the trial period and by direct debit thereafter. This is the best way of knowing whether your child is really enjoying their classes, as they will begin to feel fully immersed and settled by week 4.

#### What should my child wear to a first class at LLDS?

Understandably, before you rush out and buy dance uniform you want to be sure that your child is happy in class. During their trial, your child may wear clothes which are suitable to dance in such as leggings or soft shorts, and a t shirt or vest top. The girls may like to wear a dress or soft skirt to class for Ballet. No jeans or jewellery, please. School shoes or even trainers can be worn for tap to begin with. Once your child is settled in class they will be expected to wear the school uniform and appropriate footwear.

#### What is the school uniform and where can I get it?

Our school uniform will be available to purchase online via our website very soon! There are different uniforms for each Star group, so you will need to know which class(es) your child is attending before you order. We also have personalised uniform available for purchase, including LLDS jackets and onesies! Please email the office if you have any specific questions about uniform.

#### Do all children have to take exams to progress through their grades?

We will always encourage children to take official examinations when they are invited to do so, as we feel they are a hugely beneficial part of their dance training and provide an exciting goal to work towards. However, we understand that they are not for everybody, and should you decide to opt out of examinations, we do offer the alternative of a paid, online 1:1 assessment with our studio director, Miss Lovick, and their class tutor. This gives students a chance to showcase and celebrate their achievements in a more familiar environment.

#### When will my child be ready for an exam?

We are launching a continuous report system for each individual student, which is available to view in your Parent Portal. This new and exciting feature enables you to keep track of your child's learning and development by their 'levels' (1-5), which have been specially designed by our tutors to assess our students' technical progress. Once your child reaches level 5 (Performance level) in their class, this means they are exam-ready and will now focus on polishing their performance until the exam. There are few schools that provide this unique and personalised service, and we hope all our parents will benefit in understanding and following their child's journey with us.

#### Is there anything else my child should take with them to class?

We advise children to bring a named water bottle with them to class as it is important to be kept well hydrated. Seniors attending our longer Grade 5, Pre-vocational and Vocational classes may wish to bring a small snack to keep up energy levels.

#### How are pupils with long hair expected to wear it?

We request that all children from Galaxy Stars upwards attend classes with hair neatly groomed into a bun. Please take a look at our LLDS YouTube account for a video tutorial on how to create the perfect bun, with our studio director, Miss Lovick! For all other classes, hair must be neat and off the face preferably in a bun or ponytail.

#### Can I watch LLDS dance classes?

At the moment, parents and carers are unfortunately not allowed into our venues whatsoever due to Covid-19 health and safety restrictions, therefore we ask that you speak with your child about this in advance and make sure they are confident to enter the studio premises without you this term. Our friendly dance teachers will meet you at the door and do their absolute best to make both our new and current students feel safe, happy and welcome on their first day. Under normal circumstances, parents are allowed to enter the venue building, however we prefer that they wait outside the studio whilst class takes place. From experience, we feel there are fewer distractions for the pupils which leads to a productive and positive session. However, we are always pleased to invite parents to observe an 'open class' during our Watching Weeks, to see what the children have learned.



# COVID-19 PROTOCOL (OUR DAY TO DAY CHANGES):

Parents will not allowed into our venues AT ALL this term due to Covid-19 restrictions, therefore please carefully read and adhere to the following points to make sure you are fully prepared. Further details and venue-specific information on what to expect when arriving for classes this term will be released in advance of your child's first class:

- 1. Arrival and collection times we are going to have to be extremely strict with these as it is very important that our classes do not cross over and that we do not exceed the number of students allowed in the building at one time. Students will be allowed into the venue up to 5 minutes before their class starts, and will be expected to be picked up no later than 5 minutes after the class finishes. **Students who arrive over 5 minutes late will not be allowed into class.** Please allow sufficient time for your journeys and take school-run traffic into consideration.
- 2. Please visit the bathroom at home/school (if possible) with your child before travelling to class, as you will not be able to visit the venue bathrooms before class starts, and we want to avoid too much disruption to lessons. Children will still be given a toilet break by their teacher at a set time during the lesson
- .3. Please ensure your child arrives at the venue **already fully-clothed in their dance uniform**, with their outdoor clothes on top. There will not be any facilities for parents to change children, as they are not allowed inside the venue.
- 4. At the entrance, you will see our LLDS spots spaced 2 metres apart in a line please stand on the next available spot and wait for your child be called into the building by their teacher. Please ensure that your child brings ONLY their water bottle and a small dance bag with dance shoes inside with them into the building everything else should remain with you, as we do not have space in the studio for unnecessary items.
- 5. If your child feels at all unwell or is displaying Covid symptoms, please do not bring them to class. If your child develops Covid-19, you must immediately inform the office so that we can begin our track and trace procedure.

If we all work together and take responsibility on the above points, we can make sure that every student's return to classes is a smooth and happy experience.

# FEES

All classes are paid monthly by direct debit on the 1st of every month.

MINI Stars - 45 minutes £8.50 £21.25 per month

SUPER Stars - 60 minutes £12.50 £31.25 per month

GALAXY Stars 75 minute class £16.00 £40.00 per month

> 90 minute class £18.00 £45.00 per month

Senior Grade 5
120 minute class £24.00
£60.00 per month

Pre-vocational and Vocational
150 minute class £29.00
£72.50 per month

Your first payment will be for 2 months.
We have a one month notice period.



#### FEE STRUCTURE

All fees are moving over to direct debit. This has been a change that has been requested many times and we feel that now is the right time to change. It is to make your life easier and simpler. Here is how it will work... Fees are added up for the term and then multiplied by 3 (there are 3 terms per year) this gives us the total fees due per year. This is then divided by 12 to get your monthly payment. Your first payment is for 2 months, so that you are always paid one month in advance. This is your notice period should you wish to leave. Fees are set to be paid on the 1st of every month. Should you wish to leave the school please give us notice by the 28th of the month. Your next payment will then be cancelled but you will be able to attend classes to the end of the following month.

Here is an example of how fees have been calculated; -

Pupil attends Classic Star Grade 2 (90 mins class)

Cost per class £18.00

Cost per term is  $18 \times 10 = £180$ 

Cost per year is  $180 \times 3 = £540.00$ 

Therefore, cost per month is
540 / 12 months = £45.00 per month.

1st payment Sept £90.00 thereafter £45.00

Should you leave and there has been an under or over payment for classes taken there will be a final invoice/refund issued.


Our Super Stars program is going to be sensational. If you are a reception age pupil, then you will love our new combination classes. BALLET TAP and MODERN and funky JAZZ moves too! One hour of pure dance magic. We will teach you the foundations of dance technique working along the ISTD Pre-Primary Ballet syllabus and the super fun work of ISTD Primary Tap and Primary Modern. Then to sparkle and shine, we top it off with some funky jazz as well. Don't miss out on your chance to dance and be the STAR you know you are!



Our Galaxy Stars program will Razzle Dazzle you!!

This new combination class is specifically aimed at Year 1 and 2 pupils, taking them to the next level of dance and preparing them in ISTD Primary Ballet, Grade 1 Modern and Primary Tap.

We will also incorporate some basic AcroDance to help with the strength and flexibility of our dancers. Children in Galaxy Stars also have the option of working towards ISTD graded examinations.



After achieving the ISTD Primary Grade examination/assessment pupils can progress to the main school classes. Here they have the option of following one or two pathways, CLASSIC and/or DYNAMIC.

### **CLASSIC STARS**

A beautiful combination of Classical Ballet and Ballet Repertoire, where you dive into the history of ballet, LEARN the steps from the famous ballets, and work on choreography, costumes and presentations. As you progress, Lyrical, Contemporary and Stretch & Condition is added to your timetable. This is the total dance program for those passionate about ballet. Learning the technique, building strength and control, improving posture and balance, and ultimately growing in confidence and ability.

## **DYNAMIC STARS**

Our Dynamic Stars program offers combination classes in Ballet Tap Modern. Working along the ISTD grades, classes will incorporate all three subjects, with Jazz and Musical Theatre styles being introduced at the higher levels, to create an all-rounded triple threat performer!

The pupil's grade for DYNAMIC is always determined by their ballet level. It is normal for a Grade 2 Ballet pupil to be studying Grade 3 modern and Grade 2 tap. This would be DYNAMIC Grade 2. Our pupils will progress through the Dynamic Grades 1 to 4 with the option to take exams or assessments to move up. However, it remains the Ballet grade that determines each child's class. Ballet is the core of our dance training at LLDS, where technique is developed and encouraged to enhance all the other genres.
